Course description

Objectives:

The main objective of the course is to provide learners with a variety of tasks and assignments integrating both communicative skills and competences in order to:

- 1. Master individual communicative skills and strategies and integrate them into the use of language on a practical level effectively
- 2. Have a range of general and communicative language competences
- 3. Recognize and use a wide lexical repertoire with a number of idiomatic expressions and colloquialisms. Have a high degree of grammatical accuracy, can use intonation and accent in pronunciation in various situations and use accurate spelling with excellent paragraph layout and correct punctuation
- 4. Understand complex (and abstract) texts on a wide range of topics
- 5. Adapt language production means to the recipients and to circumstances. Use language flexibly and effectively in a variety of social and cultural contexts
- 6. Use a wide range of discourse functions and means to maintain continuous and undisturbed communication. Provide detailed descriptions and fluent, well-structured speech. Use functions on a practical level precisely and with ease

Assessment:

The evaluation of the course is ongoing.

The overall summative assessment mark consists of the following compulsory components:

- 1. Active participation in seminars (max. 2 absences are allowed)
- 2. weekly elaboration of assigned tasks

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Brief outline of the course:

Language Practice III integrates communicative skills and competences into each seminar. The description below outlines thematic areas for each week, to which attention is paid during the semester:

- 1. Motivation and inspiration (modals, vague language, contractions)
- 2. The parent trap (noun phrases, phrasal nouns, short and long vowels)
- 3. Overcoming adversity (modals, prefixes and suffixes, pronouncing in two ways)
- 4. A big adventure (participle clauses, ways of moving, consonant clusters with s)
- 5. Live your age (determiners articles, quantifiers, research language, verb and noun stress)
- 6. In love with Shakespeare (word order, idioms, reading aloud)
- 7. No more boys and girls (cause and effect, binominals)
- 8. Live to work? (perfect and continuous tenses, acronyms and initials)
- 9. An emotional roller coaster (prepositions, sentence patterns, stress in multi-syllable adjectives)
- 10. Crossing cultures (advanced structures for comparing and contrasting, individuals and populations, contrastive stress)
- 11. Hi-tech, lo-tech (prepositions of adverbs, common adverb collocations, verbs for making things, sentence intonation with adverbs)
- 12. End of term test
- 13. Course evaluation
